National Eucharistic Revival

More snippets from *This Is My Body: A Call to Eucharistic Revival*, Chapter 1: (p. 29) Peace will break out on earth, in accord with God's

first and deepest desire, when we all come together in a common act of worship... A friendship will endure only in the measure that the two friends fall together in love with a transcendent third, with some great value or good that lies beyond the grasp of either of them... Only when we give glory to God in the highest- above nation, family, culture, political party, etc.- will we, paradoxically, find unity among ourselves.

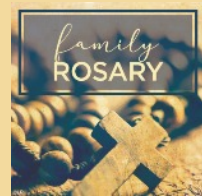
Chapter 2: (p. 36) Since the world has been twisted out of shape, it can be straightened only through a painful process of reconfiguration... God cannot allow his fallen word to remain in alienation; rather, he must do the hard work of drawing it back into communion.

(p. 37) There can be no communion without sacrifice, and thus there is no Eucharistic table that is not, at the same time, an altar.
