


Eucharistic Adoration

If you have any questions or concerns regarding Eucharistic Adoration, please give any of these people a call. Captains have been assigned to certain hours of the day: If you have any difficulty covering your hour; please give them a call.

Most people will want to adore Our Lord in their own way, and often will want to do so quietly. For this reason, please do not visit with others in the Adoration Chapel. Go outside to converse quietly, if necessary.

Parents are encouraged to bring their children. As Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me." But please supervise your children. There will be some children's books in the bookcase to occupy their time. This is also a good time to teach little ones reverence and a love for Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. You might also teach them to pray the Rosary, particularly if you are alone with your children in the chapel.

Please don't eat or drink in the chapel!

You are encouraged to use the reading material located in the Adoration Chapel, but please return it as you leave so that others might use it.

If someone shows up during your hour that is not a regular adorer, do not assume that they will be staying for the whole hour. They may just be dropping in for a visit. Please do not leave before your scheduled hour is completed and the next regular adorer has come to pray.

It is wise to arrive at least 5-10 minutes prior to your assigned hour. These few minutes can allow the present adorer to prepare to depart knowing that the next hour is properly covered.

If you can't make your assigned hour.

1. If you have arranged for a substitute, call them to make sure they will be there.
 2. If you need a substitute, you might try switching your hour with another person for that week only.
 3. If you cannot find a substitute please call the Hourly Captain to help you.
