Serving: roast beef, mashed potatoes/gravy, coleslaw, corn, dinner rolls, pie, coffee & milk (hotdogs available for children).

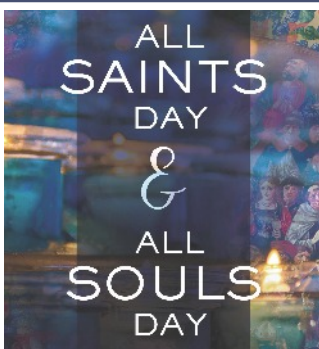
Adults: \$12, Children 5-12: \$6, 4 & under: free
