Diocesan Mass Intention Decree

"Parishes must not hold onto Mass intentions beyond one year." This is not a new rule, but new this year, the diocese is requiring all parishes to hand over any intentions that have gone unfulfilled for over one year. These intentions and the money paid for them will be forwarded to the diocese and the diocesan Office of Canonical Affairs will then send these intentions to various priests throughout the Catholic world to be fulfilled as soon as possible. This is all to ensure that these intentions for your loved ones get said in a timely matter. We have a good number of intentions at Assumption that date back quite a few years. These intentions, by request from the diocese, will be forwarded to them. The funds and the names of the deceased will be sent and these Masses will still be said. Also, please note: moving forward, that any intentions that you give to the parish in excess of 5 Masses will likely be forwarded to the diocese after one year if they are not fulfilled. I know that this might be frustrating for those affected, but please find consolation knowing that these Masses will be said much sooner if they are sent away rather than staying at the parish.

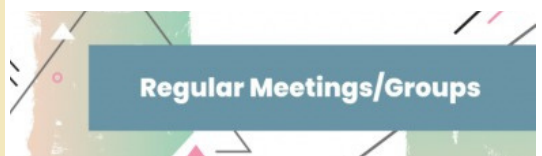

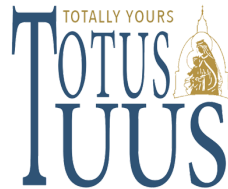
