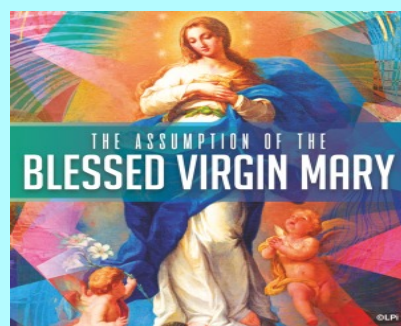
YOUTH MINISTRY
